



Medical Oncologist Locum- Starting October 11, 2021 to May 27th, 2022

Cambridge Memorial Hospital (CMH) along with Grand River Regional Cancer Centre/Waterloo Wellington (GRRCC) is currently recruiting for locum tenens coverage for a 1.0 equivalent (FTE) Alternate Payment plan (APP) Medical Oncology position.

Cambridge Memorial Hospital and GRRCC provide a full service of comprehensive cancer treatments to the 700,000 residents in the Waterloo Region, Wellington County and the surrounding area.

The successful applicant would join two other Medical oncologists and 6 GP Oncologists at Cambridge Memorial Hospital in providing specialized oncology services including the delivery of chemotherapy and participation in clinical trials.

The duties would include regular outpatient oncology clinics 5 days/week at CMH which would include participation in outpatient emergency clinics or assistance with coverage of other oncologists. The individual would be expected to treat primarily breast, lung, melanoma and GI malignancies. Opportunities for teaching with the Satellite McMaster University Faculty of Health Sciences are available and encouraged, with a stream of clerk, residents and fellows regularly rotating through the program.

Certification in Medical Oncology by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada, and eligibility for independent licensure in the Province of Ontario are required. The successful applicant must also obtain and maintain privileges at Cambridge Memorial Hospital, Grand River Hospital and other associated hospitals in the region as required.
