Additionally the Kamloops clinic has support from general practitioners specially trained in oncology and chemotherapy delivery. As part of BC Cancer and Interior Health Authority, medical staff have provincial tumour group support and tumour board conferences are available for case discussions. In the near future, clinical trials enrollment will be supported at the Kamloops site, increasing research and care opportunities.

In BC we have some of the best cancer control results in the country, with access to more state-of-the-art drug therapies than any other province. Our provincial structure is the key to our success and ample opportunity exists for collaboration across and within our tumour groups. You will report to the Department Head of Medical Oncology, BC Cancer Kelowna for issues related to patient care, research, teaching and standards of care.
