BC Cancer Kelowna operates in partnership with Interior Health (IH) ten Community Oncology Network clinics (CON) throughout BC's interior. We are medical oncologists to work in the Trail, BC CON clinic, serving the Kootenay region of BC. The Medical Oncologist working in Trail will join our well-established team in the BC Cancer Kelowna Medical Oncology department. This clinic offers cutting edge therapy in a personalized practice environment. Additionally the Trail CON clinic has support from general practitioners specially trained in oncology and chemotherapy delivery. As part of BC Cancer and IH, medical staff have provincial tumour group support and tumour board conferences are available for case discussions. In the future, clinical trials enrollment will be supported at the Trail site, increasing research and care opportunities.

Our provincial structure is the key to our success and ample opportunity exists for collaboration across and within our tumour groups.
