MEDICAL ONCOLOGIST CAREER OPPORTUNITY AT MACKENZIE HEALTH

Mackenzie Health is currently recruiting a new Medical Oncologist starting immediately, for 1.0 FTE APP position.

The Hospital

Mackenzie Health is a major regional healthcare organization that has recently expanded into a two-hospital system (Mackenzie Richmond Hill Hospital and the brand new, state-of-the-art Cortellucci Vaughan Hospital) in order to meet the rapidly expanding needs of the growing community. The outpatient Oncology clinic is located at the Richmond Hill site.

The Position

The successful candidate will join a dedicated team consisting of 4 general Medical Oncologists, 1 benign Hematologist and 2 benign/ malignant Hematologists. The Oncology clinic is complimented by on-site psychotherapist and palliative care physicians in addition to oncology nurses, chemotherapy pharmacists, full-time drug access navigator, administrative assistants, social workers and dietician. The Chemotherapy unit hosts 21 treatment chairs. Plans are underway for significant expansion and renovation of the Oncology clinic in the future.

The successful candidate would see and treat a variety of solid tumour sites with opportunity to develop site-specific focus as well. All Oncology inpatients at both hospital sites are admitted under the hospitalist inpatient care model with Oncologists providing only inpatient consultation services (not MRP) on a rotating weekly basis for solid tumour malignancies (Hematology has a separate call schedule). Along with other Department of Medicine subspecialists, Oncologists are required to round approximately one weekend every 8-12 weeks on a Medicine inpatient ward from 8 am-5 pm Sat-Sun.

There are many exciting opportunities to engage in medical education through University faculty affiliations, quality improvement, clinical research, administrative duties, and community outreach.

The Job Requirements

- Independent license or eligible for independent license with the College of Physicians & Surgeons of Ontario (CPSO)
- FRCPC(C) with certification in Medical Oncology and eligible for APP under ONT MOA agreement
- Eligible to work in Canada without restrictions
