

## ***Career Opportunity in Medical Oncology***

The Department of Medicine is seeking a Full Time Locum Medical Oncologist.

The Medical Oncologist is an APP supported position joining a team of 14 clinicians. The group sees over 2,500 new oncology consults annually and cares for patients at the Brampton Civic Hospital and Etobicoke General Hospital, with a satellite clinic at Headwaters Health Care Centre. Our program has oncologists specializing in a few tumour types each to increase expertise and has supportive multidisciplinary tumour boards. The candidate will support outpatient oncology clinics with a focus on Lung, Upper GI and Gynecologic malignancies, in addition to support in patient consultation services as per the group call schedule.

The preferred candidate must have a certificate of registration to practise from the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario and have fellowship in Internal Medicine with subspecialty in Medical Oncology from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada. Leadership experience, quality improvement experience, and clinical trials experience are considered assets. Interest in Lung, Upper GI and Gynecologic malignancies would be considered an asset.

Tentative start/end dates are April 22<sup>nd</sup> 2024 until March 1<sup>st</sup> 2025.

### **About the Program**

The oncology program is supported by a survivorship clinic, thrombosis clinic, and a nurse practitioner led urgent care clinic, in addition to proactive monitoring of patients on systemic therapy through our Oral Anti-Cancer Chemotherapy Program and Osler Cancer Immunotherapy Program. We have a strong collaboration with our palliative care team with Osler being the first community Oncology program in Canada that has the ESMO designation of integrated oncology & palliative care program. We are leaders in molecular testing and currently offer in house rapid next generation sequencing.

There are numerous unique opportunities for medical oncologists at Osler including a robust research program, engaging in numerous phase II/III clinical trials and investigator-initiated research. There are opportunities for quality improvement projects, medical education in which some clinicians have University appointments.
